Position Overview:

We are seeking a dedicated and compassionate School-Based Mental Health Clinician to join our Administrative Team in supporting the mental health and well-being of students within the school setting. The clinician will play a crucial role in reducing barriers to accessing mental health care, providing individualized interventions, and fostering a supportive environment for students. This position will also involve the implementation of the Interconnected Systems Framework (ISF), which integrates individual, family, school, and community influences to enhance student mental health outcomes.

Key Responsibilities:
