Young Beginners

9:00 AM-10:00 AM (Students entering 3rd-4th Grade in the fall who learned violin in 2nd or 3rd Grade, or **NEW-to-strings students entering 3rd-6th Grade**)

This camp will help beginners learn the basics of string playing: posture, bow control, and making a beautiful tone on the violin, viola, or cello. We'll learn or review some beginner tunes and introduce new repertoire. We'll also play some fiddle tunes.

Elementary Fiddlers

This camp will focus on growing your music reading skills and sharpening your playing technique to help you play with a beautiful, big tone. We'll play familiar songs, learn new songs (including some fiddle tunes) and get tuned up for another year of growing as musicians in the Orchestra!! 11:45 AM-1:00 PM (Students entering 5th - 6th Grade in the fall with *at least 2 years of instruction on violin, viola, cello, or bass.*) This camp is for young, but experienced musicians: **strong music readers** that have demonstrated independent learning, and good practice habits. This camp will challenge you to read quicker, more accurately, and more confidently. You'll play fun music with other motivated players while sharpening your technique to play with a beautiful, big tone. This camp will prepare you to be a strong leader in Fifth Grade Orchestra or Middle School Orchestra. Feel free to sign up for both Elementary AND Advanced (for one price)..
